LEARNING ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

The Assessment of Student Learning will be effective throughout each semester, and the result will be presented in the way of Partial Measures (MP – *Medidas Parciais*).

1st - During each school year shall be as many Partial Measures how many times (a) Professor (a) deems necessary, based on the Plan of Education, made the final record in Class Diary of only 3 (three) Consolidated Partial Measures (MPC – *Medidas Parciais Consolidadas*).

For purpose of measuring the Assessment of Student Learning, will be adopted in numerical form, to one decimal place, without approximation, obeying scale from 0,0 (zero) to 10,0 (ten).

The total Average of (three) Consolidated Partial Measures (MMPC), in each curricular component will be determined by simple arithmetic average, with a maximum of one decimal place, without approximation.

$$\text{MMPC} = \frac{\text{MPC}_1 + \text{MPC}_2 + \text{MPC}_3}{3}$$

The Final Assessment (AF) will be obtained through instruments (exams, analysis of text, discursive written work, reports of experiences and others) that may be archived for proof of their actual achievement and also be registered with a maximum of one decimal place, without approximation.

1st - Will be released from performing the Final Assessment and considered approved, the student who obtains the Consolidated Partial Measures (MPC), Final Average (MF) equal to or greater than 7.0 (seven).

2nd - Will be considered approved (AP) the student who obtains Final Average (MF) equal to or greater than 5.0 (five), given by the weighted average of the Average Consolidated Partial Measures (MMPC) and Final Assessment (AF), as follows.

$$\text{MF} = \text{MMPC} \times 0,6 + \text{AF} \times 0,4$$



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Will be considered failed in each curricular component without the right to Final Assessment, the student who:

I - does not obtain the minimum frequency (75%) in hours of the curriculum component, except in cases covered by specific legislation.

II - obtains Average of the Consolidated Partial Measures (MMPC) less than 3.0 (three) points.

The Coefficient of Performance (CR) is the arithmetic average of all final grades obtained by the student throughout the graduation. These final grades can be both the Consolidated Partial Measures (MMPC), when the student does not need to do the final assessment, and the Final Average (MF), when students make the Final Assessment (AF).
